Conditions for Salah

- 1. Faith be a Muslim
- 2. Must Be Sane and Have Reached Puberty
- 3. Purity of Body, Clothes and Place
- 4. Have Wudu
- 5. Proper covering
- 6. Face Qibla
- 7. Have intention
- 8. On time

Allah (SWT) Says in the Quran:

يَا بَنِي آدَمَ خُذُوا زِينَتَكُمْ عِندَ كُلِّ مَسْجِدٍ وكُلُوا وَاشْرَبُوا وَلاَ تُسْرِفُوا مِسْجِدٍ وكُلُوا وَاشْرَبُوا وَلاَ تُسْرِفُوا إِنَّهُ لاَ يُحِبُّ الْسُرِفِينَ

"O Children of Adam! take your adornment for every mosque, & eat & drink but waste not by extravagance, certainly He likes not those who waste by extravagance."

(Surah Al-A' raf 7. Verse 31)

From the Sunnah of the Prophet (PBUH):

The meaning of "adornment" here is the covering of the 'awrah' (those parts of the male & female body which need to be covered). The meaning of "mosque" is "prayer." Therefore, it means "Cover your 'awrah' for every prayer" (Figh us Sunnah)

Interpretation of Hadith

Narrated Aisha (RA): The Prophet (PBUH) said,

"The Salah of a woman, who has reached puberty, is not accepted unless she is wearing a khimar"

(Ahmad, Abu Dawud, Tirmidhi, Ibn Majah)

Clothing Requirements

- 1. Must cover awrah/satar
- 2. Loose not tight
- 3. Thick not see through
- 4. Men & women's clothing must not be alike
- 5. Must not imitate other religions











































































































































